Dear Parents/Carers,

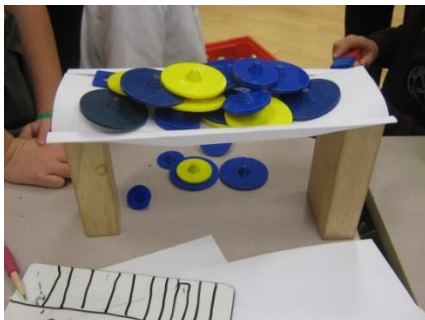
We hope that you are all keeping well as the weather starts to turn colder and are looking forward to the run up to Christmas. We have been very busy in school and would like to share some of the highlights.

### Parking



We would like to just send a reminder out about parking when coming to pick up your child. Please could you ensure that you **do not park**
