Tuesday - Singing assembly led by Mrs Emms

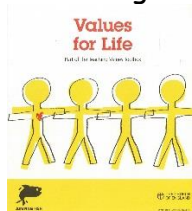
Wednesday - Whole School Bible story based assembly led by teachers.
